Denomination: Barolo Docg

Variety: Nebbiolo

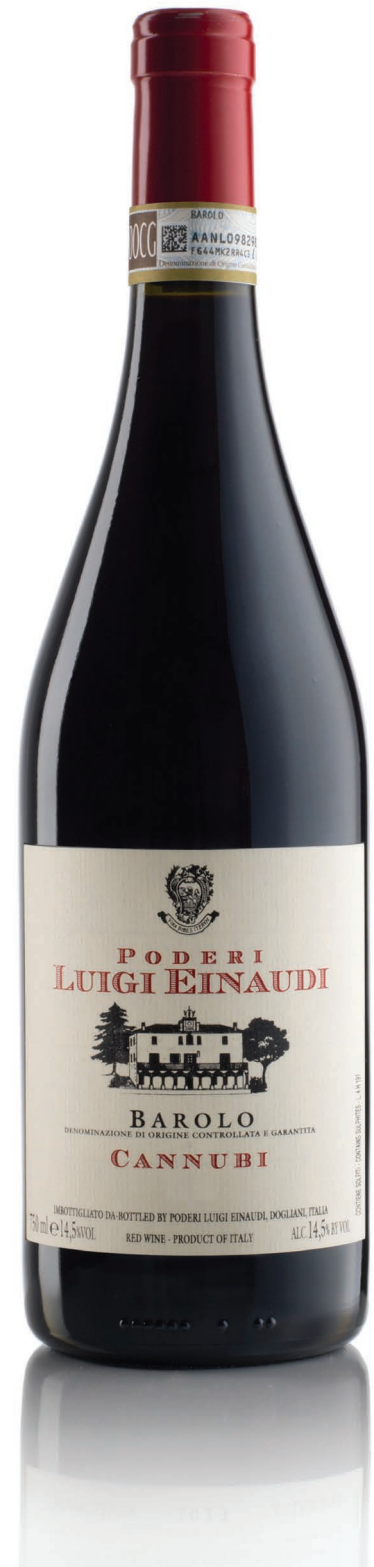
Seasonal trend: The 2012 campaign began with a fairly normal winter trend: November and December, in fact, they passed with rather mild temperatures, while January and February were characterized by a more rigid climate (in fact, it reached a peak of -10° / -15° C, as it did not happen for some time).

The heavy snowfalls that occurred during the month of February ensured a good water supply to the ground and favored a vegetative recovery postponed compared to the average for the period in the best exposed areas.

Spring was cool and rainy in March and April, in May it was milder and full of heavy rainfall, where temperatures higher than the average of the period were reached, with a maximum of even 17° C.

The summer has been perceived, since its inception, as very hot and with scarce rainfall; thanks, however, to the accumulation of water that occurred during the previous months, no delays were found for the vegetative development of the plants. As usual, the harvesting of the Nebbiolo grapes took place in October, thus benefiting from the important daily temperature changes that have occurred since the second decade of September.

It was a vintage not abundant in terms of production, but characterized by an excellent raw material from the phytosanitary point of view and with excellent organoleptic characteristics.



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Period of the harvest: 5-9th October 2012

Bottling period: 30th July 2015

Tasting notes: A wine of great class that expresses the elegance of the "Cannubi" terroir in Barolo, rich in structure, intense and with a lot of power.

Alcohol content 14.50% vol.

Acidity 5.95 g / l

Sugars (glucose + fructose) 0.3 g / l

"Aromas of strawberry, lemon and followed by hints of dried flowers in a medium-bodied wine, rich in tannins and a soft finish. A linear and very long wine, fairly balanced for the young Cannubi vineyard .
